# Visit CollegeForWV.com

College for West Virginia (CFWV) is a free, comprehensive resource for college and career information. CFWV provides detailed information on West Virginia's financial aid programs, including West Virginia Invests, the state's tuition-free community college program. With helpful tools and articles, CFWV is your one-stop source for navigating college options along with scholarship and grant opportunities in West Virginia.



# **Submit Your Application**

West Virginia's community and technical colleges have an open admissions policy, meaning all students with a high school diploma or qualifying Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC) score can be admitted. Just remember, you still need to apply to get started!

### File the FAFSA

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to be considered for federal financial aid, including Pell Grants and student loans. Filing is free at **FAFSA.gov**.

# **Send Your Transcripts**

Your chosen college will need a copy of your high school or any college transcripts on file. Be sure to send them in as part of your application process.

### **Connect with Admissions**

Schedule a conversation with an admissions representative at your college. They'll guide you through any college-specific requirements to complete before enrolling in classes.

### **Meet with Financial Aid**

Talk to a financial aid representative at your college to confirm your FAFSA submission was successful. You'll also receive an award letter outlining the financial aid you qualify for to help fund your education.

The West Virginia Community and Technical College System offers grants and programs that link companies with colleges. Whether it's customized training, skill enhancements, certificate or associate degree programs, if a company needs education or training to get a skilled workforce – West Virginia's community and technical colleges are prepared to deliver.



### Would you like your employees to have on-the-job training while earning their degree?

This grant program connects employers with Community and Technical College students, allowing students to take technical courses while gaining paid cooperative work experiences as they complete their degree or training program. The student pay is shared by the company and the college, and students receive a minimum of \$15 per hour to work in the field they are studying in. In addition, this program allows the employers to gain a pipeline of qualified employees trained with the knowledge and skills needed to succeed in West Virginia's workforce.

### **Program Highlights:**

- Students gain valuable paid work experience in their field of study.
- · Work experiences are coupled and aligned with in-class instruction.
- The grant reimburses employers for 50 percent of the student's wages.
- · Students earn a minimum of \$15 per hour.



### RAPID RESPONSE ADVANCE GRANT

## Are you trying to fill an immediate training need?

This grant is awarded to colleges to partner with businesses and industries on projects that address the state's workforce needs – including pre-employment programs, pre-preparation programs, skills upgrades, new and expanding companies, and job retention.

### **TECHNICAL PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT**

### Do you need a community and technical college to develop an academic program?

This grant program supports the design, development, and implementation of new academic or technical degree programs that are in high demand and that lead to high-wage careers. The new degree program must lead to a Certificate of Applied Science or an Associate degree. Eligible programs must target high-demand occupations that will result in wages averaging at least \$15 per hour with benefits.
